
Mid City Custom Pools Soil Stabilization 5 Year Injection Warranty and Disclaimer:

MCCP Soil Stabilization guarantees that all soil stabilization injections completed by MCCP Soil Stabilization will be performed in accordance with the stabilization chemical manufacturer's recommendations. This warranty is valid for the injected pool/outdoor living areas only and guarantees proper and sufficient application of the chemical. The injection process and chemical are designed to limit the Potential Vertical Rise (PVR) of expansive soils to approximately 1 inch or less as determined by a soil boring and swell testing. If, at any time during a 5 year period immediately following the date of injection, the injected areas have a rise of greater than approximately 1 inch, MCCP Soil Stabilization will return to the job site and re-inject the affected areas a second time for no charge. If a second injection is unable to effectively stabilize the soil, limit the potential vertical rise (PVR) to 1 inches, then MCCP Soil



Stabilization will refund the client the amount of the original invoice for the specific area(s)/structure(s) that could not be stabilized (this may mean a partial refund of the total invoice and will not exceed the total of the original soil injection invoice.) If the cause of any soil movement is in question, we reserve the right to request a soil swell test by an independent Geotechnical Engineering company to verify the location/depth of any soil movement prior to a second/subsequent injection. Both the pool belly and pool deck must be injected by MCCP Soil Stabilization for this Guarantee to be valid.

Soil injections do not protect against, prevent, nor provide warranty for the following: any destruction or damage caused by soil movement, soil erosion or soil wash out; swell of soil outside of the injection area; movement of existing structures or concrete adjacent to the injected pool areas whether attached or not; concrete flatwork or structures that are not sufficiently or properly supported, reinforced or have non-compacted or substandard fill; plumbing leaks and/or pool equipment failure.
